during the twenties the great white way roared with nearly 300 book musicals luminaries who wrote for broadway during this decade included irving berlin george m cohan rudolf friml george gershwin oscar hammerstein ii lorenz hart jerome kern cole porter richard rodgers sigmund romberg and vincent youmans and the era s stars included eddie cantor al jolson ruby keeler
