this book covers soft empty hand control issues for law enforcement officer the goal is to demonstrate to officers the understanding of the principles and appropriate use of soft empty hand control techniques law enforcement officers are authorized to use a range of force options to preserve the peace prevent crimes maintain order and apprehend suspects soft empty hand techniques are the first option of physical response used to restrain a person who is resisting by developing a high degree of proficiency with soft empty hand techniques the officer will be able to respond in a more effective manner with a minimal amount of force a police officer experiences different kinds of adverse situations while performing his her duty sometimes his her own life may be threatened due to a suspect s actions therefore it is essential for the officer to know defensive tactics to protect him her and to control adverse situations in modern society police have different responsibilities such as crime investigation providing security crime control etc therefore the officer must be aware of special tactics by which he she can defend him herself against stabbing grabbing pushing kicking using sharp and dangerous weapons and firearms within a fraction of a second a police officer must be able to react properly otherwise it may prove to be a fatal situation every officer must be aware of defensive tactics and should be able

to apply them effectively whenever required topics and techniques presented in this book will be of both great interest and great value to trainers and students of law enforcement

background in 1996 the naval special warfare command developed a new set of tactically appropriate battlefield trauma care guidelines named tccc the tccc guidelines were adopted by the u s special operations command ussocom and approved by the american college of surgeons acs and the national association of emergency medical technicians the committee on tccc was established in 2001 and was directed to further develop the tccc standards and guidelines the committee on tccc functions as a working group of the trauma and injury subcommittee of the defense health board dhb which has a charter to provide medical recommendations to asd ha and the service surgeons general tccc concepts were incorporated into the 8404 corpsman training curriculum in 2005 the tccc cls trainer course was developed in 2006 to provide corpsmen as trainers to teach and sustain tccc standards to corpsmen and cls skills to selected marines within the operating forces the implementation of tccc across all services has been identified as one of the contributing factors to the highest combat casualty survival rates in history and is recommended by asd ha for use when training combat medical personnel ref b tccc information is published in the prehospital trauma life support manual phtls military edition which is updated every four years department of defense dod approved tccc training curricula are updated on the dod website mhs osd mil education and training tccc.aspx as the tccc guidelines change goal eliminate preventable loss of life on the battlefield in accomplishing this goal the most recent tccc guidelines approved by dod are to be utilized as a means of providing standardized training to the marine corps and improving first responder care at the point of injury history of tccc a it is important to realize that civilian trauma care in a non tactical setting is dissimilar to trauma care in a combat environment tccc and cls are an attempt to better prepare medical and non medical personnel for the unique factors associated with combat trauma casualties b historical data shows that 90 of combat wound fatalities die on the battlefield before reaching a military treatment facility this fact illustrates the importance of first responder care at the point of injury c tccc was originally a us special operations research project which was composed of trauma management guidelines focusing on casualty care at the point of injury d tccc guidelines are currently used throughout the us military and various allied countries e tccc guidelines were first introduced in 1996 for use by special operations corpsmen medics and pararescue pjs f the tccc guidelines are currently endorsed by the american college of surgeons committee on trauma and the national association of emergency medical technicians the guidelines have been incorporated into the prehospital trauma life support phtls text since the 4th edition student curriculum tactical combat

this book covers officer survival skills issues for law enforcement officer the goal is to develop the law enforcement officer's understanding of officer survival for the safe and efficient performance of their duty the majority of police officers duties become routine though the potential for danger is always present the duties of the officer require them to enforce laws and to control the illegal actions of certain citizens survival techniques if properly applied provide the officer an opportunity to overcome the resistive behavior of subjects these techniques also provide officers with self confidence which is needed to win when an officer uses force peers the public the media the government and the world review that actions if the officer applies inappropriate force it reflects poorly on the individual and gives a non professional appearance to the entire force the officer is subject to legal limitations when the officer is faced with a violent situation it is required that he make decisions in a fraction of a second he may have to justify his actions in court therefore proper defensive tactics training provides the officer with the tools required not only to apply the proper techniques but also to decide the proper level of force necessary to overcome resistance this will obviously enhance officer survivability insure proper performance during the situation and justification in court topics and techniques presented in this book will be of both great interest and great value to trainers and students of law enforcement

this book covers handcuffing issues for law enforcement officer the goal is to understand and be able to perform proper techniques of using handcuffs handcuffs are temporary restraining devices designed to control the movements of a subject officers may routinely use handcuffs to control restrain and transport persons restraining devices will be applied properly and in accordance with training received so as to minimize the risk of unnecessary injury the design of handcuffs ensures that the subject's movements are controlled to reduce the risk of injury to the police officer members of the public and the subject himself the most common types of handcuffs used in law enforcement today are the traditional and hinged variety in addition officers also use plastic cuffs in some situations handcuffs do not entirely immobilize a suspect regardless of the type used it is imperative that officers be aware that the police style handcuff is a temporary restraining device and that its proper use and application is crucial for the safety of the officer and subject topics and techniques presented in this book will be of both great interest and great value to trainers and students of law enforcement
